Due to the high interest and demand from applicants for the English-language doctoral program, we are announcing:

- Media Arts/Digital Media (program in English) 6 places
- Media Arts/Digital Media (program in Georgian) 4 places

The "Media Arts/Digital Media" doctoral program aims to educate modern researchers whose knowledge is based on the possibilities of new technologies and the synthesis of traditional disciplines in the visual arts. Admission to the doctoral program:

Applicants, who acquired a master's degree or a degree equal to this according to the Georgian legislation or who acquired a foreign degree that is recognized under the Georgian legislation (in accordance with Article 50 of the Law of Georgia "On Higher Education") and who meets the admission requirements defined in the doctorate program can be enrolled in TSAA doctoral programs according to Georgian legislation on the grounds of the internal assessment as defined by the program.

Applicants must submit:

- Information about educational and practical experience (resume)
- Master's degree or equivalent
- Research proposal in English
- English level B2 (in the absence of such a document a university exam will be arranged)
- Interview

Registration:

Applicants for doctoral programs are required to submit the following documents:

- 1. Application (addressed to the dean)
- 2. Applicant's personal information (CV)
- 3. Master's degree or equivalent a notarized copy of a document certifying the information about education

- 4. In case of receiving higher education in a foreign country, notarized translations of the diploma and appendix and the document recognizing the education received abroad
- 5. Copy of identity card; Copy of identification card/passport (for citizens of foreign countries notarized translation)
- 6. Information about practical experience (resume, at least 3 years) in the relevant field
- 7. Certificate confirming knowledge of a foreign language at the B2 level (if such is obtained for the doctoral candidate) together with a notarized copy (see the list of certificates recognized by TSAA)
- 8. Research Proposal in English, in which the research problem will be posed and the candidate's vision on ways to solve it will be given
- 9. In addition, Interview and visual material (portfolio), considering a proof of competence

Applicants for admission to the English-language PhD program "Media Arts/Digital Media" and who have proof of knowledge of the English language at B2 level and do not need an additional exam must submit the documents: Online registration (uploading documents) **August 13 – September 23 of 2024**
