Kastamonu University (KU) Erasmus Institutional Coordination Office has announced the call for incoming student mobility for studies within the framework of Erasmus+ KA171 (Third Countries not associated to the Programme).

The applications will be accepted through the [Application System](#) of Erasmus+ Institutional Coordinator within the dates stated in the **CALENDAR** section.

The student mobility for studies must be realized during the **Spring** semester of **2024-2025** Academic Year from **17 February 2025** to **13 July 2025**.

MOBILITY INFORMATION

The **Student Mobility for Studies Call** is open to all students studying in ISCED-coded fields specified in the **QUOTA** table. Please see the detailed quota table for the list of ISCED-coded fields. The students from fields that are not included in the **QUOTA** table are ineligible for this mobility.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- The applicant has to be a full-time enrolled student (Bachelor, Master, or PhD) at the sending institutions that are given in the detailed quota table.
- The applicants are required to have a course load equivalent to 30 ECTS in the programs they are registered in.
- The Cumulative General Point Average (CGPA) of the applicant has to be at least:
 - for undergraduate students (Bachelor) **2.20/4.00**
 - for post-graduate students (Master or PhD) **2.50/4.00**
- The English language level of the applicant must be at least B2 according to CEFR levels.
- The total duration of the mobility within the same study cycle (Bachelor, Master or PhD) **cannot** exceed 2 months.



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APPLICATION PROCESS

The applications will be made through <https://applyerasmus.kastamonu.edu.tr> during the application period specified in **CALENDAR** section.

The applicants should upload the required documents listed below to the application system during their application. The documents must comply with the conditions as specified below. More information about the conditions supportive documents must meet can be found in the **SELECTION CRITERIA** section.

Required documents:

- **Application form with photo** (must be signed by the applicant student and Erasmus/IRO coordinator before uploading)
- **Biometric Photo**
- **Proof of Enrolment** (official document showing)
- **Copy of National ID Card**
- **Copy of International Passport**
- **Proof of Educational Degree** (only for Master and PhD applicants)
 - for Master applicants last Bachelor Diploma
 - for PhD applicants both Bachelor and Master Diploma
- **Official Transcript of Records in English** showing CGPA score (if not available in English, an officially signed and stamped document by the university declaring CGPA is also accepted along with the original document.)
- **Europass CV** ([Click here](#) to create your Europass CV)
- **English Language Proficiency Level** (for details on how language proficiency score will be calculated, please see Language Proficiency and Language Exam section.)
 - **University English Language Exam Result** (you can upload this after the application process ends if your Institution will hold an exam specifically for this call. If you have an English proficiency exam score conducted by your university in the 2023-2024 academic year, you can use that score in this application.)
 - **eu|academy Placement Test in English**
- **Valid certificate for disabled students** (Certificate can be any document authorized by the applicant's home country's officials.)
- **Certificates of attendance of the participants' previous Erasmus+ mobilities.**

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY AND LANGUAGE EXAM

Applicants have to prove their current language level in English. In order to obtain a current language score, the applicant has to take a language certificate by attending a placement exam on eu|academy. The certificate's PDF file must be uploaded to the application system within the application dates. The second step is to attend the language proficiency exam of the sending university (the applicant's university). The sending university may organize a new exam specific to this call or allow the applicants to use the scores of the previously made exams (only exams held during the 2023-2024 academic year are accepted). Details of the calculation of the language proficiency score are given below.

DEFINITIONS

Definition of Student Mobility for Studies (SMS)

- This mobility activity is carried out within the framework of existing inter institutional agreements of the higher education institution.
- The activity consists of the project coordinator and the student, who is registered in partner higher education institutions, to carry out a part of his education in the higher education institution that is partnered with an inter-institutional agreement.
- Students are expected to be sent/received to follow the program corresponding to 30 ECTS credits for one semester in order to do the work required by their diploma/degree.
- The minimum duration for mobility is 2 months. Mobilities less than 60 days will be ineligible, and the student will refund all grants.
- Students who meet the application requirements can benefit from the activity without a grant.

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SELECTION CRITERIA

The evaluation criteria have been determined by Kastamonu University Erasmus Institutional Coordination Office within the scope of the Erasmus+ Handbook for Higher Education Institutions published by the Directorate for EU Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Türkiye (Turkish National Agency), the Directive of International Relations Office, and Directive of Erasmus Program of the Kastamonu University, Republic of Türkiye

¹ Converting CGPA grades into 100 point scale will be made based on suggestions of the applicant's home institution

² at least B2 level of English according to CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) is required. The language score will be converted to a 100-point scale based on the reference table below to calculate a total point.

The applicant's home university can hold a language competency exam for their students. If the applicants have an English proficiency exam score conducted by their university in the 2023-2024 academic year, they can use that score in this application. Documents of exam results must be signed and stamped by the officials of the applicant's university.

***All documents provided by the applicant must be in English or translated into English. Documents translated into English must be approved by the university's Erasmus/IRO coordinator.

****In case of equality in the ranking, the following criteria shall be applied respectively until the equality is broken:



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- Student with a higher language proficiency score
- Student with a higher CGPA

To ensure an objective and transparent selection the evaluation of applications will be made by an evaluation commission officially appointed by the Rectorate of Kastamonu University in accordance with the Erasmus+ Handbook for Higher Education Institutions published by the Directorate for EU Education and Youth Programs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey (Turkish National Agency), the Directive of the International Relations Office of the Kastamonu University and the Erasmus Program Directive.

The results will be announced on the website of the Coordination Office (<https://erasmus.kastamonu.edu.tr>). Commissioners will not be able to benefit from this exchange program due to the rules of the National Agency.

The participants will be asked to provide documents proving their way of travel to receive the Green Travel Grant amount. The Travel Grant and the Green Travel Grant will not be paid separately; the participants will receive only one of the travel grants.

DEDUCTION FROM THE GRANT

The higher education institution makes a grant deduction in the following cases, provided that it is announced before the mobility and stipulated in the contract:

1. If the documents proving participation in the mobility are not submitted, the mobility will be deemed invalid and the grant will not be paid to the personnel, and the initially paid grant will be collected. In addition, grant deductions are made for activities that occur less than planned or are not appropriate.
2. Except for technical reasons, personnel who do not fill out the participant survey will be deducted at the rate of 20% of the travel grant calculated according to the total number of activity days and distance band on which the grant is calculated.
3. If the mobility period is less than the minimum period, regardless of force majeure, the mobility in question will be deemed invalid and no grant payment will be made.
