From April 11 to 19, 2024, Ilia State University hosted the second international meeting of the European Commission-funded project "Responsible Conduct of Research – Research Integrity and Ethics in Georgian Universities (ETHICS)." The meeting took place at the Free University of Amsterdam. Participants included representatives from ten Georgian higher education institutions and three European universities, non-university partner organisations from Europe, officials from the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia, the Shota Rustaveli Foundation, and the National Center for Education Quality Development.

Attending from the Tbilisi State Academy of Art were Tamta Tamar Shavgulidze, Head of the Scientific and Creative Research Service, and Christine Darchia, a Guest Lecturer - meeting aimed to present a report on the project's development stages by the consortium members. Georgian higher education institutions reported on the training of academic and scientific staff. At the same time, European organisations shared updates on the components for which they were responsible in the project, including the research integrity module and doctoral program standards.
